16.4 Glenelg Town Hall Stage 2 Repairs (Report No: 314/08)

Significant damage was caused to the northern section of the Glenelg Town Hall building in May 2005. Baulderstone Hornibrook Pty Ltd, having previously accepted responsibility for the damage, proposed a two (2) stage repair and reinstatement process to rectify the damage. Stage 1 repairs, comprising a footing injection technique to stabilise the building, were completed in February 2007. This report presents the scope of works proposed for Stage 2 repairs, namely internal and external cracking repairs together with associated carpentry, rendering, painting and floor coverings. Negotiations to reach a satisfactory scope of works have been protracted, however the full suite of works now proposed and agreed to by the negotiation parties is recommended to Council for approval.
