This report provides an annual overview of the City of Holdfast Bay's work health and safety (WHS) Management System performance with respect to legislative obligations under the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 and associated Regulations, Return to Work Act 2014 and associated Regulations, ReturnToWorkSA (RTWSA) Performance Standards for Self Insured Employers and Code for the Conduct of Self-Insured Employers under the RTWSA Scheme.

Additionally, the report highlights progress on planned WHS actions, findings from the Local Government Risk Services Plan and Program Review, psychosocial hazard management initiatives, and key WHS performance data.
