GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

Disclosure and evidence of policy

The permit holder shall not commence the activity until evidence of such public risk insurance policy is given to Council. Such policy shall bear the endorsement of the Insurer indicating the Insurer accepts the indemnity given by the permit holder.

Permit not transferable

The permit is not transferable.

Removal of industrial bin/shipping container

No object, material, matter or other related item shall extend outside of the industrial bin/container or approval area as indicated in this permit. The industrial bin/container, matter, material or other related items shall be removed by the expiry date and the road or footpath shall be left clean or tidy.

Security of area

The permit holder shall ensure that the area is adequately lit at night and that all appropriate barriers, barricades and warning devices are installed to protect the public.

The permit holder shall also ensure that the industrial bin/shipping container does not obstruct the vision of motorists, or unduly obstruct the passage of pedestrians.

Damage and repairs

The permit holder shall be responsible for all repairs, damage or rectification work, to any footpath, road, service or other Council property resulting from the issuing of this permit, in default, Council may complete any repairs necessary and recover the cost from the permit holder.

Revoking or amending of permit

This permit may be revoked by Council if the permit holder fails to comply with, a condition of this permit, a direction of Council, or any other justifiable circumstances, in which case Council may arrange for removal of the container/rubbish.

Any reasonable costs incurred by Council as a result of the permit holder's failure to comply with the permit will be recovered from the permit holder.
