Some out of hours and weekend work will be required.

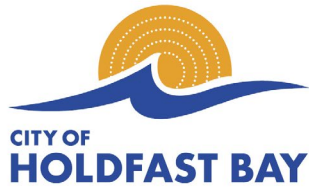
### The right person will have skills and experience in the following:
