

## **TRANSPORT**

### How do I get to Adelaide Airport?

- Bus J1 on Colley Terrace, approximately 25 minutes to airport.
- Bus 300 on Colley Terrace, approximately 20 minutes to Harbour Town.
- Taxi 10 minute cab ride for around \$20.
- Uber ride sharing service is available.

### When does the City tram run?

- Departs every 10 minutes during peak hours and every 15-20 minutes out of peak hours.

### Where in Glenelg can I hire bicycles?

- Moseley Square, Glenelg, outside of the Stamford Grand Adelaide.
- In the carpark off Glenelg Pier Hotel, Holdfast Promenade.
- Broadway, Glenelg Bicycle Hire (outside the Norfolk Motor Inn).

Glenelg has some scenic trails by foot or bike including the Coast Park to Seacliff and Mike Turtur Bike Way to the city.
