

WANDERING CAT

Dear Neighbour,

This is just a note to let you know, in case you are not aware, that your cat is wandering from your property. I thought that it would be best to advise you in the first instance to allow you an opportunity to address the cat's behavior without lodging a complaint with Council.

Please be aware that Cats are not permitted to wander and cause a nuisance to neighbouring properties. Council has a **Cats Bylaw – 6** which states that Cats are not to be a nuisance.

The cat is causing a nuisance by: *(Please tick relevant issue/s)*

Wandering onto my property without my permission

Defecating or urinating on my property / public property

Displaying aggressive behaviour

Injuring other animals

Damaging property

Wandering onto the footpath road reserve playground

Causing a general nuisance (describe)

Night time

Weekdays

Weekends

When you are not home

Other specific time
