- Which vaccines are available?

 Vaccines as listed for babies, children,
 adolescents and adults on the National
 Immunisation Program (NIP)* are available
 (except Shingles vaccine) at no cost with
 a current Medicare Card, this includes flu
 vaccines for designated groups.
- Do I need to book?
 Yes. Online appointments are preferred.
 Walk-ins will be available time permitting with bookings prioritised.

What if I can't remember which

vaccinations I've already had?

The council keeps a record of all vaccinations administered through our services. A history of vaccinations is also available on the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), which can be accessed on your myGov/Medicare portal. What should I bring? Current Medicare card and 'My Health and Development Record' (Blue Book) for children up to 10 years old and immunisation history/record card/relevant correspondence for adolescents and adults.
